METHODOLOGY NOTES

- Owing to operational considerations, the survey was not conducted in Syria. Instead, the respondents were Syrians currently living in Lebanon. WIN/Gallup International's local partner in Lebanon used the seed contact and snowballing approach to locate and survey Syrians in Lebanon.
- Random sampling was used in 15 countries; per the above, the seed and snowballing approach was used to locate and survey Syrians in Lebanon.
- The sample size in the United States was 5,000 as the Washington delegation of the ICRC had planned to carry out a survey in the United States and the two projects were merged.
- Results were weighted to ensure a representative sample of the population under review.
